

NOTICE TO BOAT OWNERS FOR BOATS LEFT IN THE MARINA DURING THE 2021 HURRICANE SEASON, JUNE 1 TO NOVEMBER 30

Boat owners that plan to leave their boats in the Marina, unattended, during the 2021 Hurricane Season should prepare them before leaving BWC. The diagram below shows the ideal way to moor your vessel for optimum protection against high winds and storm surge.

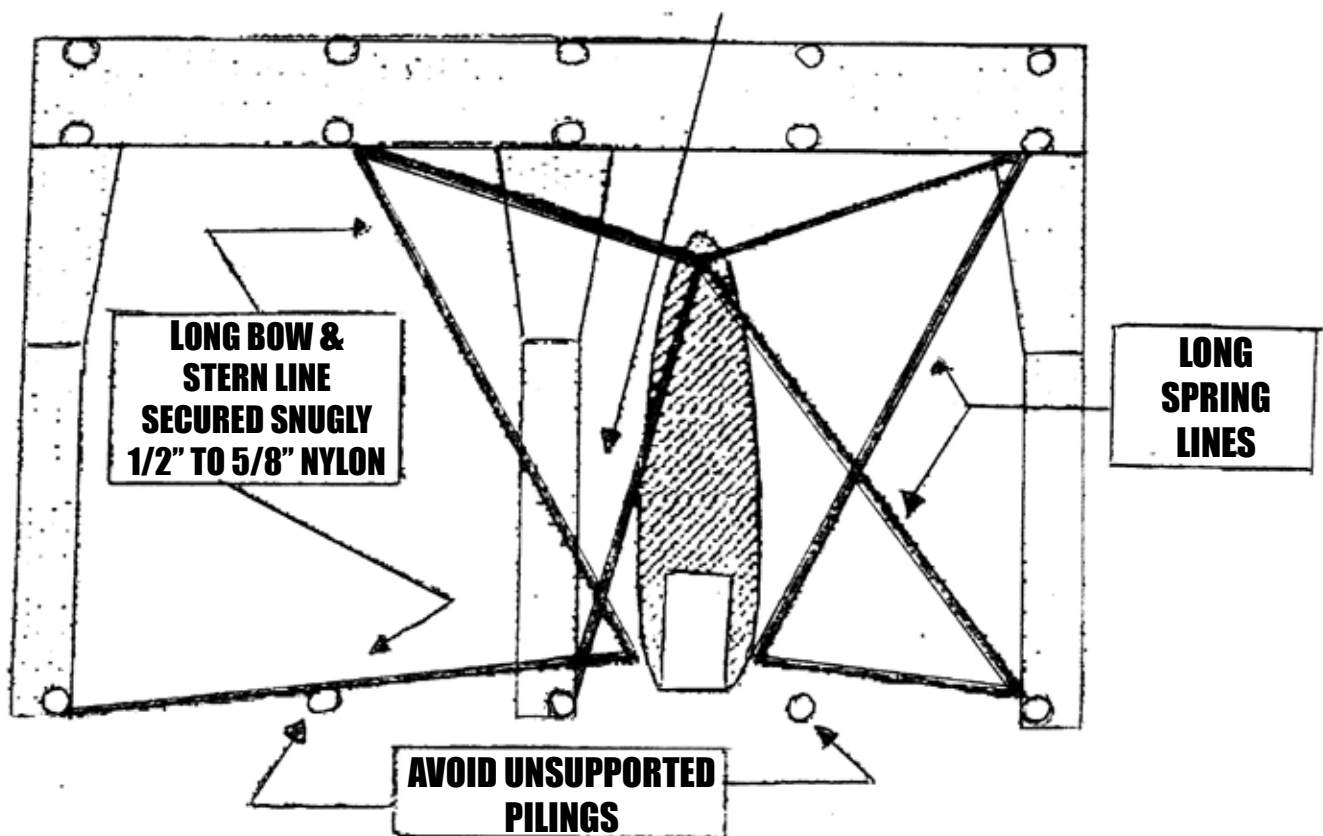
Special rules apply during this period. If the adjacent slips are not in use, you may tie across them and also moor your boat more toward the middle of the two slips.

In slips #1 through 142, you may tie your lines across the lower dock to the pilings under the Boardwalk instead of the cleats. If you tie across adjacent slips, however, be sure the tag end is tied to a finger pier pilings so that if the adjacent slip user comes back before you do, the line can be removed.

Any vessel that is left in the Marina must have a minimum of 5 lines holding it in place, two for the Bow, two for the Stern, and a Spring Line to keep the boat from winding up on the Lower Dock. Non motorized vessels should be moved off the Finger Piers, they are not required to have insurance, and should they become loose and cause damage, you could be held personally responsible.
